The intelligent co-teacher that provides live lesson feedback, classroom summaries, and video recording.

How does M2 work?

M2 shares tips and ideas for how to improve instructional practices in the moment. M2 feedback focuses on Tier 1 instruction and the science of learning. You can also give M2 your own objectives and assign objectives to others. Have M2 ask you a question, start a student discussion, summarize lessons and lectures, tell jokes, and more.

Start a live feedback session

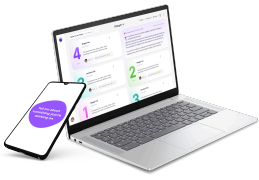
- ✓ **To log in**, download the app “MirrorTalk: Reflection with AI” ([iOS](#), [Android](#)) or use the email and password you signed up with at mirrortalk.ai
- ✓ **Remote**: Remove it from the dock in the back and unwrap the cord to create the lanyard. Press and hold the power button until the LED goes solid. The remote functions as a microphone, a personal assistant: “ask M2” a question by pressing and holding the white dot button, and when worn, can track the user’s movements when recording video
- ✓ Select “Personal” from the Group dropdown menu and Click “New”
- ✓ Enter your Objective or a Standard, select the grade of your students, and the interval for receiving feedback to appear on the screen
- ✓ Tap anywhere on the screen to start. You can exit or pause the live feedback feature at any time. Your session summary will appear on the dashboard. Reflect after the session on the device or MirrorTalk on the web
- ✓ **Video Recording**: tap the video icon in the bottom right corner to start recording

Start a live feedback session

- ✓ **Ask M2**: During live feedback, teachers and students can ask M2 any question. Click ‘Hold to ask M2’ on the screen or press and hold the white dot button on your remote.

Share insights and recordings

- ✓ From the device or MirrorTalk account on the web: share session and reflection summaries to a MirrorTalk Group from the three-dot menu. Tap the evidence icon to transfer video recordings to **Reflectivity**.

Get started with MirrorTalk online

Try a sample reflection

- ✓ Select "Personal" from the dropdown menu.
- ✓ Click "New" to do a guided reflection. Think of a professional goal you would like to reflect on. Click "Done" when finished

Set up your first activity

- ✓ Create a Group. Select "New" from the dropdown menu at the top.
- ✓ Click "New" to create an activity. Click "Custom" to make your own or choose from the "Examples."
- ✓ Enter a learning objective by recording into your microphone or typing. This will prompt MirrorTalk AI to generate reflection questions.

Share the activity link with participants

- ✓ Click "Assign" and share the link via email or learning platforms.
- ✓ View the reflection insights in the group dashboard by clicking on each participant's card.
- ✓ Group Summary Lesson will automatically be generated on the dashboard and it will be emailed to you
